1. **Welcome, Advice on Public Delegations for Consideration**

2. **Matters Arising from March 2016 Meeting**

3. **Site Update:**

Quarterly Update of Operational Activities at the Landfill:

Landfill activity has been moderate in the past 3 months. Current incoming volumes are from regular baseline customers with little to no event projects.

Review of Monitoring:

Monitoring:

Particulate Matter (PM10):

March 2016 – 0 MOE 1/HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

April 2016 – 3 MOE 1/HR average exceedances and 1 daily average MOE exceedances

May 2016 – 16 MOE 1/HR average exceedances and 0 daily average MOE exceedances

March – no exceedances

April - exceedances were due to Centennial Pkwy traffic.

May – exceedances were due to Centennial Pkwy traffic and landfill activity due to high winds.

Review of Complaints:

Over the past three months the site has received five odour complaints over a three week timeframe. One complaint e-mailed to Terrapure Staff, with the remaining four complaints reported to the MOECC.

All complaints were investigated and reported back to the complainants, City of Hamilton and the MOECC within a timely manner.

Status of Applications Pending with the MOE:

No applications pending.

Heritage Green Community Trust Activities Update:

The Heritage Green Community held their AGM on May 30, 2016. This year the Trust handed out four grants totalling of \$708,044.66 for various projects within Upper Stoney Creek as well as eight scholarships totaling \$20,000.00. The Trust will break for the summer and will reconvene in September 2016.

Greg Jones reviewed with the committee of the remaining operations at the site. At this time Greg announced that Terrapure will be applying to the MOECC to amend the current ECA to go back to the original footprint of the site in order to take waste in on the remaining area. Greg and Lorenzo answered questions and addressed concerns the committee had with respect to the project. The announcement to the community will take place on June 7th with a Public Open House scheduled for Tuesday June 21, 2016 from 4:00 pm until 8:00 pm at the Salvation Army Winterberry Heights Church.
