Particulate Matter (PM10):

Sept 2015 – 6 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 1 daily average exceedances

Oct 2015 – 10 MOE 1/HR average exceedances and 1 daily average MOE exceedances

Nov 2015 – 0 MOE 1/HR average exceedances and 0 daily average MOE exceedances

Sept – exceedances were due to landfill activity and construction from surrounding housing development construction.

Oct - exceedances were due to landfill activity and construction from surrounding housing development construction.

Nov – no exceedances

No other unusual results.

Review of Complaints:

There were no complaints over the past three months. Mr. Alfano addressed a concern that was brought forth by a local resident by Councillor Conley with respect to the height of the East Landfill Site.
