**1. Welcome, Advice on Public Delegations for Consideration**

Sarah Solter welcomed the committee.

**2. Matters Arising from March 2020 Meeting**

*Site tour for new committee members:* Due to COVID-19 Pandemic all facility tours have been cancelled for the time being. Terrapure will put together an orientation presentation and will arrange a WebEx prior to the next CLC meeting in September for those new members as well as anyone else who might be interested.

### 3. Site Update:

#### **Quarterly Update of Operational Activities at the Landfill:**

Activity around the site has been moderate over the past 3 months. Current incoming volumes are from regular baseline customers and event volumes. Due to the COVID-19 restrictions, activity has slowed down by approximately 40%.

#### **Review of Monitoring: Particulate Matter (PM10)**

March 2020 – 0 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

April 2020 – 3 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

May 2020 – 0 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

March – No exceedances

April – Exceedance due to: Facility activity with high winds.

May – No exceedances

#### **Review of Complaints:**

The Stoney Creek Regional Facility received 5 complaints:

- 1) April 24, 2020: Ward 9 Councillor called regarding several odour complaints. The source was due to waste relocation activity.
- 2) May 9, 2020: An odour complaint was made while the site was not in operation and the wind direction did not support grievance.
- 3) May 11, 2020: Odour complaint
- 4) May 11, 2020: Visual complaint
- 5) June 1, 2020: A complaint was called into the Ward 9 Councillor's office on May 14<sup>th</sup>. Complainant was concerned with odour and visual.

#### **Status of Applications Pending with the MECP:**

No applications pending.

#### **Heritage Green Community Trust Activities Update:**

The Trust held it's Annual General Meeting on May 25, 2020 via WebEx. This year the Trust awarded six grants totaling \$541,939.65 and eleven scholarships totaling \$27,500.00.
