#### **Quarterly Update of Operational Activities at the Landfill:**

Landfill activity has been fairly steady for the past 3 months. The site has been very busy and has received significant volumes from various projects within Ontario.

Dec 2014 – 2 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

Jan 2015 – 11 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 2 daily average MOE exceedances

Feb 2015 – 0 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average MOE exceedances

Dec: Exceedances were contributed to Upper Centennial Pkwy traffic (road salt)/landfill activity/offsite fugitive dust/high winds.

Jan: - Exceedances were contributed to Upper Centennial Pkwy traffic (road salt)/landfill activity/offsite fugitive dust/high winds

Feb: No exceedances

#### **Review of Complaints:**

There is only one complaint to report in February but the source is unknown. The landfill was closed due to severe winter weather. Wind direction was coming from the NW, given the location of the landfill and the complainant's residence the landfill could not have been the source of the odour.

#### **Status of Applications Pending with the MOE:**

No applications pending.

#### **Heritage Green Community Trust Activities Update:**

Trust is currently accepting applications for the scholarship program as well as Grant Applications. The Annual General Meeting for the Trust is scheduled for May 25, 2015.
