1. Welcome, Advice on Public Delegations for Consideration

2. Matters Arising from December 2019 Meeting

Discussion after interview of Community Representative Candidate:

Prior to the start of the CLC meeting, members of the committee met with an interested candidate for the open Community Representative position. The interview went very well as the members felt this candidate would be a great addition to the committee.

3. Site Update:

Quarterly Update of Operational Activities at the Landfill:

Stripping of phase #1 of previously capped cell to prepare for landfilling within new capacity is nearly complete.

Site activity has been moderate in the past 3 months. Current incoming volumes are from regular baseline customers (primarily AMD). Event volumes have increased in the past 3 months since the expansion approval.

Review of Monitoring: Particulate Matter (PM10)

Dec. 2019 – 1 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

Jan. 2020 – 1 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

Feb. 2020 – 0 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

Dec. – Exceedance due to: Centennial Parkway traffic, road salt

Jan. – Exceedance due to: winds out of the South, suspect Centennial Parkway traffic, road salt

Feb. – No exceedances

Heritage Green Community Trust Activities Update:

The Trust is now accepting both Scholarship & Grant Applications with the deadline for submission of April 1st.

As part of the new EA conditions Terrapure was instructed to invite members from various Indigenous communities as well as a representative from both the local Public and Catholic School Boards to participate as non-voting members of the CLC. The Representatives from the HWDSB and HWCDSB indicated a desire to attend meetings. An introduction of both members to the committee as well as a brief overview of the mandate of the committee was discussed.

The CLC received a motion from the City of Hamilton stating Councillor Collins was resigning from the Terrapure CLC with Councillor Clark taking his place as the City of Hamilton Representative.

Kathy Lacasse's term on the CLC will be complete in June therefore her last meeting will be June 1, 2020. The committee will be accepting applications to find Kathy's replacement.
