1. Welcome, Advice on Public Delegations for Consideration

2. Matters Arising from June 2015 Meeting

- ***Set up tour of the landfill site for new committee members***
Lorenzo Alfano took both Councillor Pearson and Josie Bonaventura for a tour of the landfill site. Mr. Alfano explained the operations of the site as well as the landfill liner design.
- ***Circulate information on the landfill monitoring program to new committee members:***
Rotek Environmental compiled a one page information sheet on the PM10 monitoring program here at the landfill site. A copy of the information sheet was given to all committee members and Mr. Alfano explained the information on the monitoring system to the committee as well as reviewing how the site handles complaints.

3. **Site Update:**

Quarterly Update of Operational Activities at the Landfill:

Landfill activity has been very busy for the past three months due to various project works.

Review of Monitoring:

Monitoring:

June 2015 – 0 MOE 1 HR average exceedances and 0 daily average exceedances

July 2015 – 32 MOE 1/HR average exceedances and 5 daily average MOE exceedances

Aug. 2015 - 9 MOE 1/HR average exceedances and 0 daily average MOE exceedances

June - No exceedances

July - Exceedances were due to landfill activity and construction from the nearby Empire Developments (North of Green Mountain Rd.)

August - Exceedances were mainly due to Upper Centennial Pkwy traffic, fugitive dust from Mud Street traffic and landfill activity.

Review of Complaints:

There were no complaints over the past three months.

Status of Applications Pending with the MOE:

No applications pending.

Heritage Green Community Trust Activities Update:

The Trust will be starting to meet in early October, at this time there is nothing new to report.

4. **New Business:**

The Committee welcomed Josie Bonaventura as the newest community member with the CLC.

The Grand Opening of the Passive & Leash Free Dog Parks opened in late June. There was a great turnout at the event and the parks continue to have lots of activity since the opening.

A new Drone Technology was used at the landfill site in August. Mr. Alfano reviewed with the committee what the Drone is looking at and the process in which this can be completed.
